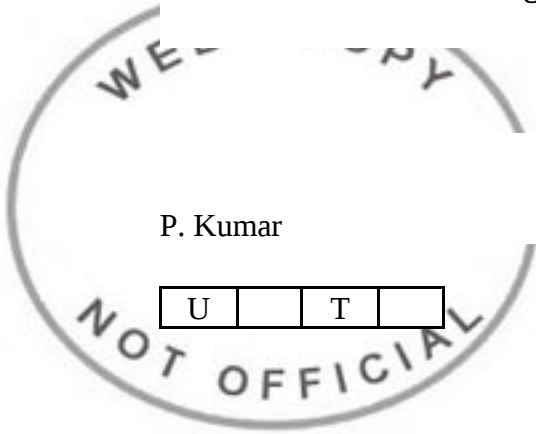
Heard learned counsel for the parties.

From the two reports called from the Court below, the second one dated 25.04.2016 states that two months time shall be taken for disposing the case.

In view of more than four months having elapsed and it is not in dispute that the trial is proceeding on a day to day basis, this Court is not inclined to consider the prayer for release of the petitioner on bail as the trial itself is likely to be concluded, if not already done, very shortly.
