In absence of any supporting material with regard to the bills, expenses and vouchers, that too with regard to the so called treatment, taken in the year 1989, there cannot be any decisive mandamus, issued upon the respondents to settle the claim of the petitioner on the head of the reimbursement of medical claim at this belated hour as is being done now by the petitioner.

The explanation that the necessary evidence was submitted but is lost cannot form the basis for a mandamus in vacuum.

Writ application is, therefore, dismissed.
