There has to be certain flexibility granted to the administration if efficiency in public service to the people at large has to be provided.

The Court will not entertain the writ application. However, it will give liberty to the petitioner to raise her grievance at the highest level where the allegations being made against the Director, L N J P N Hospital will be looked into and appropriate decision taken. If the petitioner files such an application before the Principal Secretary, Health, Government of Bihar, a decision must be taken within a period of eight weeks from the date of its filing.

Writ application is dismissed with liberty as above.
