This issue was earlier raised by the petitioners in a
previous writ application. The Court had very clearly and

categorically negated their prayer by virtue of Annexure-3 dated 23.04.2015.

Annexure-5, the order impugned, is the natural corollary to Annexure-3 as well as a policy of the Central Government with regard to the cadre transfer between two States.

No interference is, therefore, warranted with Annexure-5. Writ stands dismissed.
