Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

Three hundred bags of rice each containing 45 Kg total weighing 132.75 quintals were recovered from a truck when the truck driver suggested that he was taking the rice for the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is not a PDS dealer rather petitioner is grain dealer. Admittedly recovery has not been made from the petitioner.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender

before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Panapur P.S. Case No. 01 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
