The challenge in the present petition is to the transfer of
the members of the Indian Administrative Services.

The challenge to the transfers of the officers of the
Bihar Cadre is sought in a writ filed in public interest. The public
interest writ petition in service matters is not maintainable. Still
further, transfer of the members of the All India Services can be

challenged by an aggrieved person before the Central Administrative Tribunal constituted under the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985. We find that there is no public interest and it appears that the writ jurisdiction has been invoked to protect one or the other member of the cadre.

We do not find any merit in the present writ petition. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
