ORAL ORDER

2 24-02-2016 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being parents of husband of victim are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code and under section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of dowry demands.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that specific accusation of demand of motor cycle and freeze as dowry is against the husband of complainant. The accusation against these petitioners is omnibus and general.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Dalsingsarai, Samastipur in connection with complaint Case No. 327 of 2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
