Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is some issue with regard to arrears of salary as well as pension. The fact is not seriously disputed at this juncture by counsel representing the University.

Let the petitioner bring above facts to the notice of the Registrar of the University, who shall verify and take steps for payment, if found to be payable, within a period of three months thereof.
