2 03-03-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 420, 366 and 120B of the
Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made to have kidnapped a girl and
took away illegally. It has been said that the girl was missing
along with jewellery and cash of Rs.80,000/-.

In view of the statement made under section 164 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure by the girl, in the event of arrest
or surrender within four weeks from today, let petitioners,
namely, Nirmala Devi, Niraj Kumar and Suraj Kumar be

released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Saharsa in connection with Bakhtiarpur P.S. Case No.248 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
