By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks a direction to be issued to the respondents no.2 and 3 to immediately arrest the private respondents no.4 to 7, who have been made accused in Bettiah (Mufasil) P.S. Case No.465 of 2014 registered, *inter alia*, under Section 364 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code with a further direction to the respondents to

investigate the case properly.
