Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a complaint case wherein process has been directed to be issued after cognizance being taken for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is that the petitioners took ₹1.25 lakhs to get the daughter of the complainant employed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that there is no proof with regard to payment to the petitioners and the petitioners' side also lodged Baddi (Sheosagar) P.S. Case No. 198

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., 1st Class, Bikramganj, Rohtas in connection with Complaint Case No. 591 of 2013 , subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
