2 16-03-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 65 (2), 54(1), 65(4), 27(d) of the
Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Section 7 of the E.C. Act.

There is an allegation of contravention of Drugs and
Cosmetics Act. Allegation has been made that petitioner has not
followed the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in the
event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, let
petitioner, namely, Nageshwar Prasad, be released on
anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten

thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No.237 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal procedure.
