The challenge in the present writ application is to the
shifting of Registration Office to Jagdishpur Sub-Division for Sahar,
Agiaon and Garahani Block of Bhojpur District and the prayer is to
shift the registration office to Ara Sadar Sub-Division.

We find whether the registration office should be at
Jagdishpur or at Ara Sadar Sub-Division is an administrative
decision and not amenable for judicial review.

We do not find that there is any statute, rules or



regulations which prohibit opening of registration office at Jagdishpur Sub-Division.

Accordingly, the present writ application is dismissed.
