2 07-09-2016 Engagement of Anganwari Sevika is not a permanent appointment under the State but is hiring on contract. If the two authorities down below have not found the things in order in the manner in which selection of the petitioner was done and that led to interference, this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India would only opine that the Court has to prima facie satisfy itself that the petitioner was given adequate opportunity to place his or her case and there has been consideration. The observation of the authority rests upon the observation of the High Court, which cannot be said to be misplaced in the given facts and the

nature of engagement.

Writ has no merit. It is dismissed.
