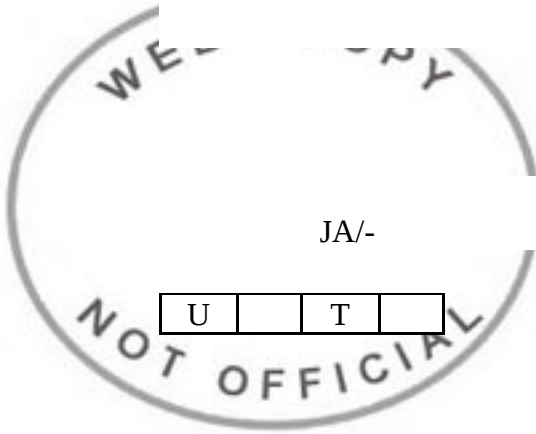
In the nature of dispute between the parties, the matter was referred to the Patna High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre, but unfortunately the dispute could not be resolved.

Considering the merits of the case, provisional anticipatory bail granted to the Petitioner by order dated 25.05.2015 in connection with Complaint Case No.501 of 2014 to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nawada, is hereby confirmed on the same terms.

The amount of ₹750/- (seven hundred fifty) payable by the Petitioner to his wife is increased to ₹1500/- (one thousand

five hundred) with effect from today.

The application stands disposed off.
