Heard the learned counsel, Mr. Vijay Shanker Tiwary, for the plaintiff petitioner.

Perused the order passed by the Court below. It appears that the pleader commissioner was examined as witness in the case and the cross-examination has already been made. Therefore, the relevancy, reliability or otherwise of the pleader commissioner evidence or report shall be considered finally by the trial Court at the time of argument of the case or at the time of passing the Judgment.
