2 04-02-2016 Heard Mr. Binay Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioners, and Mr. Anil Kumar Sinha, learned G.A.9, appearing for the State-respondents.

Though, upon registration of Encroachment Case/Misc.
Case No. 01 of 2013/14, the proceedings for removal of

encroachment, which form the subject matter of this writ application, made under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, in the form of *Public Interest Litigation*, has been initiated, there is no perceptible progress in the said Encroachment case.

In the circumstances, indicated above, we hereby, in the interest of justice, direct the respondent No.4, namely, Circle Officer, Pipra, District Supaul to expeditiously deal with and dispose of Encroachment Case/Misc. Case No. 01 of 2013-14, in accordance with law, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner may furnish to the respondent No.4, the certified copy of this order along with a copy of the present writ petition with annexures thereto.

With the above observations and directions, this writ application stands disposed of.
