ORAL ORDER

3 29-11-2016 The petitioner is wife of opposite party No. 2.

Opposite party No. 2 has been made accused in Magadh Medical P.S. Case No. 136 of 2014 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 379, 323 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code. Opposite party No. 2 has been granted anticipatory bail by an order dated 07.02.2015 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Gaya passed in ABP No. 2322 of 2014.

The petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted to the opposite party No. 2. It has been alleged that opposite party No. 2 is having illegal custody of a minor child, aged about three



years.

Upon perusal of the petition, I find that there is no allegation that opposite party No. 2 has been ever misused the privilege of bail granted to him after his release on bail.

In my opinion, no case for cancellation of bail is made out. This application is accordingly dismissed.
