2 22-06-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

This application has been filed by the petitioner for
cancellation of bail granted to opposite party No. 2 vide order
dated 18.11.2013 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 44236 of
2012. The opposite party No. 2 is the husband of the petitioner. He
was allowed bail by this Court in view of fact that relationship
between the petitioner and opposite party No. 2 might improve
and they may attempt to resolve their dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
despite undertaking given by the opposite party No. 2 that he will
keep the petitioner with honour and dignity, he has misbehaved

with the petitioner and, therefore, the bail granted to the opposite party No. 2 should be cancelled.

I do not think the allegations as made in the application make out ground for cancellation of bail. Apparently, matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and the opposite party No. 2 is the reason behind the entire litigation.

This application does not deserve any merit, it is, accordingly, dismissed.
