ORAL ORDER**

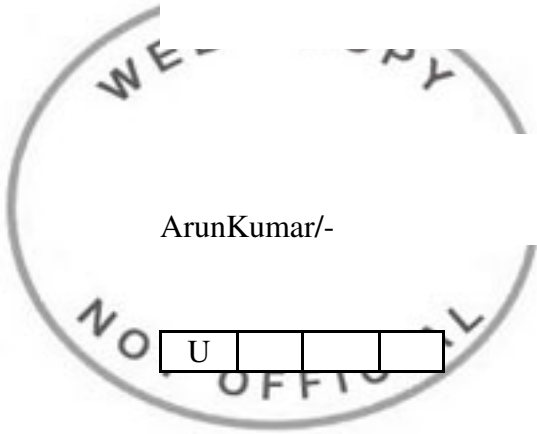
