Heard counsel for the petitioner, counsel for the BPSC and
counsel for the State.

The Court has gone through the service career of the
petitioner which has been produced on behalf of the respondents, for
the work done under contract. Petitioner does not add up to 5 years of
service; therefore, he cannot be granted 25 marks as weightage in the
selection. The total length of service is less than 5 years and therefore,
the total marks awarded to the petitioner must be only 20 and not 25.

The innovation of submission does not alter the actual period
of work experience which can be the only basis for award of marks or

weightage.

No case for a direction or reconsideration is made out. Writ application is dismissed.
