ORAL ORDER

3 23-08-2016 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court to protect the life and property of the petitioner from the hands of respondent nos. 6 and 7. Respondent nos. 6 and 7 are sons of the brother of the petitioner.

It shows that there is inter se dispute between the close relations. Therefore, the petitioner cannot be permitted to invoke the extra-ordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court to claim protection of his life and property as the private dispute can very

well be raised before the Civil Court.

In view of the said fact, no order is called for in the present writ petition. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
