an ex-army man. In view of Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the
Union of India has already constituted Armed Forces Tribunal for
redressal of the grievance of ex-personnel and army personnel.

the Armed Forces Tribunal for redressal of his grievance and if the
petitioner approaches before the same, the Tribunal will take a
decision and pass order in accordance with law.
