This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Brahmpur Police Station Case No. 57 of 2014, disclosing offence under Sections 395 and 398 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of accusation, I am not inclined to grant the petitioner privilege of anticipatory bail.
