nature of mandamus for adding her name in the voter list of 60,

series he submits that for the purpose of addition of name of the petitioner along with some others a proceeding was initiated in which they were asked to appear before the Electoral Registration Officer –cum- Block Development Officer but the petitioner has failed to comply the same and as a result the proceeding was dropped. It is stated by Mr. Prasad that should the petitioner file a fresh application it would be acted upon.
