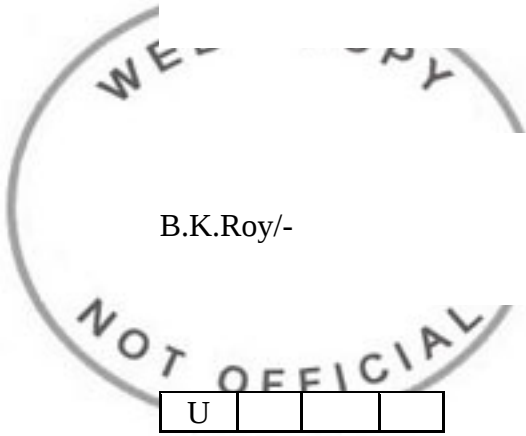
Heard learned counsel for the review petitioner.

2. We are not satisfied that any ground for review is made out, specially in view of the fact that the unsuccessful writ petitioner had retired long before the writ petition was taken up for final hearing, and his grievance was with regard to a departmental examination for promotion.

3. In view of the fact that he had superannuated, even if the writ petition is restored, in our view, no relief can now be granted to the writ petitioner; restoring the writ petition would be a

futile exercise. We are, thus, not inclined to interfere in the matter.

4. This review application is, accordingly, dismissed.
