This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Kudhani P.S.
Case No. 05 of 1998, disclosing offences under Section 395 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Considering the seriousness of the allegation and the fact that the
petitioner has criminal antecedent, I am not inclined to entertain this
application.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail is rejected.

four weeks from today and seek regular bail, if so advised. If he does so, his
application for regular bail shall be considered on its own merit, without
