Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being the parents of the husband of the informant are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 498A and 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of the dowry demand. It is also alleged that the husband of the informant namely Vivek caused injury on the neck of the informant by knife. Earlier also case with similar accusation was filed but the same ended into compromise.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the accusation against the petitioners are omnibus and general and thrust of accusation is against the husband of the informant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named

petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Aurangabad Mahila P.S. Case No. 04 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
