The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were not arrested on the spot. Nothing has been

recovered from the possession of the petitioners. Mundrika Rai was apprehended and he also confessed his guilt but did not disclose the name of the petitioners, save and except form the confessional statement of Umesh Sah there appears no material against the petitioners, but it appears that anticipatory bail petition of Nand Lal Manjhi, a similarly situated co-accused, has already been disposed of vide order dated 08.09.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 36313 of 2015 with a direction to surrender in the learned Court below and seek regular bail. Co-accused, Mundrika Rai, has already been granted regular bail vide order dated 05.08.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 28438 of 2015.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the anticipatory bail petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender in the learned Court below and the learned Court below shall consider the bail petition of the petitioners taking into consideration that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Mundrika Rai, Umesh Sah and Binod Ram have already been granted regular bail and dispose of the bail petition of the petitioners preferably on the same day.
