2 19-05-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of
Nawada Sadar P.S.Case No. 424/2015, disclosing offences under
sections 304/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, has
submitted that the petitioner runs a Nursing Home in the name of
'Ma Seva Sadan' at Nawadah. He has further submitted that the
First Information Report does not indicate any specific act on the
part of the doctor or hospital administration, leading to death of
the wife of the informant. It has further been submitted that the
doctor, who had conducted operation in the Nursing Home, did
possess the requisite qualification.

Considering the nature of allegation, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, abovenamed, in the event of his arrest/ surrender before the court below within six weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in Nawada Sadar P.S.Case No. 424/2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the police/ court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
