Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to
withdraw the application so far as the Petitioner no. 1 is concerned.

The application is dismissed as such.

The rest of the petitioners who are the in-laws seek quashing
of the order of none discharge dated 11.11.2013 passed by the Sub-
Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabd in Complaint Case No. 811
of 2011.

The case of the complainant is that she was married with the
Petitioner no. 1 on 07.06.2011 where after she went to her

matrimonial home. However, the in-laws started misbehaving and ousted her from the matrimonial home.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that fact of the matter is that Petitioner no. 2 and her relatives had gone to see the daughter of Vishnudeo Prasad. He had shown another girl and by fraud the marriage was performed. It is on account of this a dispute arose between them and the Petitioner no. 2 was compelled to file a case of cheating against the family members of the Opposite Party no. 2 bearing Complaint Case No. 890 of 2011. The present complaint and allegations of torture for non-fulfillment of dowry is false.

Having considered the aforesaid, the application is allowed and the order of none discharge dated 11.11.2013 passed by the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabd in Complaint Case No. 811 of 2011, is hereby set aside so far as Petitioners 2 and 3 are concerned.
