Any claim against the Power Holding Company on behalf of the present set of petitioners, who are the second wife and off-springs from the second wife, can only be made by a proper declaration of civil court of competent jurisdiction. This Court is not inclined to pass any order in favour of the petitioners in the writ jurisdiction.

The petitioners are free to approach the civil court for whatever claim which they would like to raise against respondent no.9 or the estate of the late husband.

The writ petition is dismissed.
