ORAL ORDER

2 30-05-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners who are the mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the complainant are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

Accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the accusation is omnibus and general in nature and the husband Mukesh Kumar @Mukesh Kumar Mehta has already been granted anticipatory bail in Cr. Misc. No. 21220 of 2016 by this Court.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named

petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Patna City, Patna in Complaint Case No. 702C of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
