Informant has appeared. Heard the parties.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in Bhabua (Sonhan)

Police Station (PS) Case No 246 of 2016 instituted under Sections 379/34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The allegation is that allegedly the informant's wheat crop was being illegally harvested by the petitioners by means of a harvester. Learned counsel for the petitioners draws attention of this Court to the order of the learned Sessions Judge wherein he has already noticed that there are title suits pending amongst the parties and there is a subsisting land dispute between the parties.

Be that as it may, in the event of their arrest or

surrender within four weeks from today, the petitioners abovenamed shall be released on bail on each of them furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabua in Bhabua (Sonhan) PS Case No 771 of 2015 subject to all conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
