Writ application is dismissed for the sole reason that any candidate working in another State, may be with similar kind of department cannot become a ground for challenge to the advertisement for appointment on a post in the State of Bihar.

The Court is of the opinion that deliberately the Court was sought to be misled on certain factual aspect of the matter.

Even otherwise, this Court has dealt with such

matters earlier and those orders passed in this regard are part of counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents. The rationale and reasoning given therein also applies to the present case.
