Writ application has been filed for a direction upon the respondents to pay to the petitioner his emoluments by virtue of the fact that initially he was appointed as a Panchayat Shiksha Mitra and then he became a Panchayat Teacher.

A counter affidavit on behalf of the State has been filed, in which a stand has been taken that the petitioner does not have a valid degree and supposed to have a degree from Hindi Vidyapeeth, Deoghar, which is not a recognized degree, for which a notification, contained in Annexure-A, dated 25.08.2008 has been annexed.

This counter affidavit was served upon the petitioner way back on 25th of September, 2014.

No rejoinder has bee filed.

In view of the same, writ application is dismissed, as petitioner, obviously, has been illegally or wrongly appointed on the post, without having valid qualification in this regard.
