3 16-09-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the deceased and

is languishing in jail custody since 07.02.2015 in a case registered

for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B), 201/34 of the

Indian Penal Code.

Para-8 of the case diary goes to show that the

investigating officer found sign of burning on the wall of toilet and

it is alleged that deceased was burnt to death in the said toilet.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as

well as submissions of the parties and also taking note of this fact

that deceased died within seven years of her marriage in other than

normal circumstances and there is allegation of illegal demand as well as torturing against the petitioner, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail and hence, his prayer for bail in connection with Sessions Trial No. 297 of 2015 arising out of Bettiah Town (Kalibag O.P.) P.S. Case No. 639 of 2014 pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge-III, Bettiah, West Champaran stands rejected.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and try to conclude the same at the earliest.
