learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 268, 290, 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 47(A) of Bihar Excise (Amendment) Act.

140 litres toddy is said to have been recovered near a cinema hall and petitioners and some others were caught by the informant when they were trying to flee from the place of occurrence. However, having similar allegation, some co-accused have already been granted privilege of bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 106 of 2016.
