learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under

Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the deceased but

from perusal of the entire case diary, I find that not a single

witness claimed to have seen the actual killing of the deceased. It

is admitted case of the informant that on 3.3.2016, petitioner along

with one Hira Lal Mukhiya had gone to his house and gave

information regarding missing of deceased and on 5.3.2016, the

dead body of the deceased was recovered from a field.

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and

circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, particularly

keeping in mind that only suspicion has been raised against the petitioner and investigation against him has already been completed, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Katihari in connection with Korha P.S. Case No.53 of 2016.
