APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 01.01.2016 in
connection with Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 166 of 2015 for the alleged
offences under Section 398 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely
implicated as in fact the petitioner was a victim of rash driving by
the informant. It is submitted that no recovery of any arms or
weapons was made from the conscious possession of the petitioner
to connect him to the offence alleged.

4. Having regard to the entirety of the facts and
circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten
thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction

of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motiharii (East Champaran) in connection with Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 166 of 2015 on the following conditions -

(i) That one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence.

(iii) That the petitioner shall remain physically present in court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
