Despite repeated calls, none appears on behalf of the petitioner in support of the present writ petition, though the name of the learned counsel appearing on his behalf is printed in the daily cause list. However, I have heard the learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 to 3.

The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 02.12.2014 passed in Case No. 18 of 2013-14 by the respondent D.C.L.R., Banmankhi, Purnia, as contained in Annexure-3 to the writ petition, whereby aforesaid case filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 48E of The Bihar Tenancy Act, 1885 (in short "Act,1885") has been rejected.

In the considered opinion of this Court, against the order impugned, the petitioner has an alternative and efficacious remedy before the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna in view of

the provisions contained in Section 9 of The Bihar Land Tribunal, Act, 2009.

In above view of the matter, the present writ petition is dismissed, but liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna for grant of appropriate relief (s) to the petitioner with respect to the lands in question as also the order impugned.
