learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with

Siwaipatti P.S. Case No. 44 of 2014, registered under Section

3/4 of Explosive Substance Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. In course of investigation,

the name of the petitioner has been surfaced in the confessional

statement of co-accused Md. Abdul and Manjoor Alam, except

the confessional statement there is nothing against the petitioner

to show his involvement in the present case. Further submission

is that petitioner is accused in four other cases, but he is on bail

in all cases. The petitioner is in custody since 02.09.2014.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of

the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur in connection with Siwaipatti P.S. Case No. 44 of 2014 (S.T. No. 845 of 2014.
