By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek quashing of the first information report (for short “the FIR”) of Kankarbagh P. S. Case No. 397 of 2015 registered under Section 498-A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner

and learned counsel for the State and perused the FIR as contained in Annexure-1 to the present application. The allegations made therein do attract the ingredients of an offence punishable under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code.
