learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections-25(i-b)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Petitioner was caught red handed, while he was fleeing
after committing loot. The looted articles, stolen motorcycle and
country-made Katta are said to have been recovered from
conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is
languishing in jail custody since 13-05-2015 but taking into
account facts and circumstances of the case as well as criminal
antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to release the
petitioner on bail and accordingly, his prayer for bail in connection
with Baikunthpur P.S. Case No. 85 of 2015 stands rejected.

However, learned trial court should expedite the trial of
the petitioner and try to conclude the same as early as possible.
