ORAL ORDER

3. It is submitted that the petitioners had been regularly appearing before the committing Court but after commitment, default was committed as the petitioners had gone to Punjab for earning their livelihood. The petitioners thereafter *suo motu* surrendered on 06.06.2016.

4. Considering the submissions on behalf of the petitioners, let the petitioners above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge Vth, Danapur, (Patna) in connection with Sessions Trial No. 260(B) of 2012, Trial No. 372(A) of 2016 arising out of Akilpur P.S. Case No. 15 of 2011,subject to the condition that the petitioners shall remain physically present on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure to do so on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
