These matters have been placed under the heading

“To Be Mentioned” at the instance of the learned counsel for the petitioners in both the writ applications.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in title page of the order dated 23.12.2016, the names of the petitioners and the respondents have been wrongly typed as the names of some of the petitioners and some of the respondents have been repeatedly shown and further the name of respondent no.2 Aam Janta has been wrongly shown therein though the name of the respondent no.2 Aam Janta has been deleted by previous
