learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under

Sections 461, 379 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

No doubt, petitioner carries criminal antecedent but in
the present case, paragraph-76 of the case diary goes to show that
when petitioner was arrested, the footage of C.C. T.V. was shown
to him and the petitioner identified one Rajesh Yadav while the
said accused was breaking the shutter of A.T.M. machine.
Moreover, co-accused Rajesh Yadav has already been granted
privilege of bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. So far as
petitioner is concerned, except the aforesaid material, there

appears to be nothing against him.

Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in connection with Kako P.S. Case No.21 of 2016.
