The petitioner wants to renew his prayer for bail, which was earlier rejected vide order dated 13.05.2016 passed in Criminal Misc. No. 14492 of 2016, in the light of observation made therein that the petitioner may renew his prayer of bail after examination of Shiv Raj Kumar during trial and that Shiv Raj Kumar has been examined as PW-1 and he has been declared hostile. During cross examination he has further stated that his uncle is leaving separately from his brothers.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Learned Additional Sessions Judge-V, Bhagalpur in Session Trial No. 729 of 2015 arising out

of Kahalgaun (Shivnarayanpur) P.S. Case No. 306 of 2015, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
