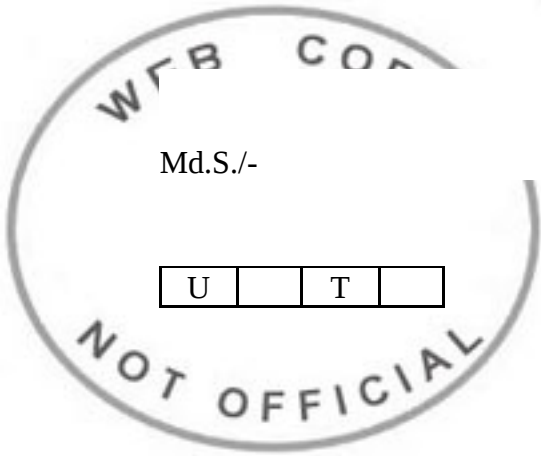
ORAL ORDER

the petitioner submits that since the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, he has instruction from his client not to press the revision application filed against the order dated 10.9.2009 passed in Misc. Case No.35 of 2009 by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Madhepura whereby the learned Principal Judge, Madhepura rejected the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 126(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside the ex-parte order dated 15.1.2009 passed in Misc.
