2 22-11-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted under
Section 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is of committing
abduction of the minor daughter of the informant, while the
informant along with victim was going to Sheohar to catch bus.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 10.07.2016. The charge sheet has
been submitted in the present case. The petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely
been implicated in the present case. The victim has been
recovered. Her statement has been recorded under Section 164 of

the Cr.P.C., in which, she has not supported the allegations made in the F.I.R.

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Sitamarhi in connection with Runni -Saidpur P.S. Case No. 280 of 2016.
